



We grow habitat while growing food. Every year we plant native trees, shrubs and plants on our farm and leave seeded out non-crop plants in our fields to feed birds over the winter. Wild crop relatives are extremely important in every landscape! They are the cornerstone of genetic diversity.

We use an old 8N Ford Tractor to farm our small fields which allows us tight turning range. We can have trees and shrubs next to our fields for habitat.

We make sure our produce is super fresh and that our root cellars are well maintained in order for our products to have the highest quality.

100% ORGANIC

We make our own fertilizers and use organic based insect repellents during the growing season using things like garlic, cayenne pepper, neem oil, and fish emulsion.

100% WASTAGE

We package in glass or compostable containers. We recycle our farm waste back to the field after it is composted. We don't use plastic or irrigation systems in our fields.



Industrial agriculture compacts and kills the soil microbiome with chemicals, sheds contaminants into surface and groundwater, contaminates dust that blows everywhere, destroys habitat, leaks oil and adds combustion gases to the atmosphere, causes damage to roadways from heavy equipment, requires subsidies to stay in business and immigrant labor to keep costs down.
